HISTORY & SHOWS

1979: Dealer, Trev Short – Lead vocals & guitar, Pete Gentil – bass & vocals, Steve Tarrant – guitar & vocals, Mal Hanselman - drums, launch themselves by gigging extensively including supports to Motorhead and Gary Moore.

1983: Following various line-up changes release the single "Better Things To Do" – recently listed in Record collector in the top 10 most collectable metal singles.

1986: More line-up changes ensue before the debut album "First Strike" is released through NWOBHM specialists Ebony records. There follows by an extensive UK tour. With no support from the record label the band folds.

2000:Rock Factory Studios releases a series of early Dealer recordings, originally for fans and NWOBHM enthusiasts, including the highly acclaimed "Bootlegged" album and a massive Internet buzz starts.

2008: ONR records (Greece) release worldwide the CD album "Bootlegged" on licence from Rock Factory Studios

2009: High Roller Records (Germany), release a vinyl version of "Bootlegged" which sold out it's first pressing immediately.

2010: Dealer reforms for a "one-off" reunion gig minus original drummer Mal (Rupert Irving fills the slot). A recording of which, ironically titled, "The Final Concert" was released to much acclaim –

2011: With new guitarist Steve Peril, Dealer embark on their first tour of Russia, performing 10 sold out dates in 10 days! Dealer then went on to play a storming set at the prestigious Hard Rock Hell festival in Wales. ONR Records (Greece) releases worldwide, their debut album "First Strike" on CD for the first time! The release featured 2 bonus tracks.

2012 /13: Dealer tours the UK and writes new material, Headlining the Phoenix Festival with a reported gate of 18,172, following which Dealer were invited to play at Heavy Metal Maniacs Festival in Holland and the Bristol NWOBHM Festival amongst other European dates. In September Dealer is put on hold due to the tragic death of original bass player Pete Gentil.

2014: Following a year of contemplation, Dealer returns with their new bass player Tom Bull ready to play the Heavy Metal Maniac's Festival in Holland and with their attention set on touring, writing and recording.
